Dear Jordan,

It is with great pleasure that I officially advise you of your selection into the Touch Football Tasmania Boys' Under 18 Team to compete at the 2024 DoorDash National Youth Championships. The Championships will be held at C.Ex Stadium Coffs Harbour, from 25th to 28th September.

It is a fantastic honour and opportunity to represent Tasmania at the highest level of the sport. I know you will carry yourself with respect and professionalism and continue to maintain the strong culture of Touch Football in the state.

Details of the training schedule will be communicated to you by the coach as soon as possible. The player levy for the tournament will be \$550, which is payable by **Friday 28th June**. The payment can be made by following this method:

Search "Tasmania"

Select the team 2024 NYC Tasmania Thunder Player Levy

Complete registration and pay the player fee.

The Player Levy includes training fees, medical support, support to coaches and managers, field hire and awards. The levy is non-negotiable and any player with any outstanding debt to TFA will not be permitted to participate in the event.

There will also be a \$110 registration fee that will be payable once player registrations for the tournament open closer to the event.

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Please note that due to a TFA policy change accommodation, flights and ground transport are now not included in the levy, and not arranged on the behalf of players and officials.

Complete the registration process through to the additional items page and select the items you wish to purchase, then complete the payment and select "Complete Registration".

Compulsory items for all participants are playing singlet, shorts or tights, socks, off field polo and casual shorts; if you have these items from a previous tour you do not need to purchase new ones (unless they don't meet the branding requirements below). Optional items include hoodies, training singlets, hats, visors, backpacks and trackies. All playing uniforms must have the DoorDash-branded NRL Touch Football logos, so if you have current kit without the DoorDash-branded logo you will need to order new kit. Please see sizing charts at www.infernosports.com.au before ordering. Uniform orders need to be completed no later than Wednesday 29th May.

Funding assistance can be found from a number of sources; we are aware that most local councils have funding for state sporting representatives, affiliate competitions will also provide a small amount to help their players, and there are special grants available from the Tasmanian Institute of Sport, and other private sponsorships are available. We are also aware of state government assistance, with detailed information and application forms here:
