We intend to conduct a Jersey Presentation Function at Wentworth Park Howrah on Saturday 4th September. More information about this event will come out in August. Please keep the date free for a late afternoon function.

There is also a requirement this year that all players in the under 16 teams be a qualified level 1 referee by the time the summer season begins. We will be running a course on 18 July, and anyone who is not yet qualified will need to attend either this course, or be enrolled for a level 1 course being run by affiliates in September or October prior to attending NYC. This qualification will improve your understanding of the game, and also provide you with an opportunity to earn a small income to offset the cost of travel for future events.
