DoorDash National Youth Championships 2025

1st – 4th October, 2025



Logistics	Information
1. Event	The 2025 DoorDash National Youth Championships will be held in Coffs Harbour NSW from Wednesday 1 st to Saturday 4 th October. The teams will have a reporting time and a release time, outlined below.
2. Match Venue	All games will be played at C Ex International Stadium and precinct, Coffs Harbour NSW.
3. Accommodation and Flights	Touch Football Australia policy requires all players, staff and parents to book their own flights and accommodation to and from the NYC tournament. Team Coaches and Managers will communicate with all players and parents in their team to suggest accommodation options.
4. Cost & Levy Breakdown	The player levy for NYC will be approximately \$550 inc GST for all players. The levy will include the following: • Payments to support coaches and managers • General event expenses including awards and playing equipment • Medical & physiotherapy support, recovery procedures, including ice, eskies, water tubs etc • Ground hire for training sessions and selection trials • Venue hire in Coffs Harbour for pre-tournament training and team gathering. • Training “Camp” (up to individual coaches to implement) • Jersey Presentation event to be held at Elwick Racecourse, Hobart (tbc). Date tbc (most likely Sunday September 21) Please note that the levy excludes player uniform, and is an otherwise all-inclusive figure and portions of the levy cannot be removed. There will also be an individual registration cost of (est.) \$110 payable when registering for the event in September, which is not covered in the above Player Levy. Players who have not paid in full by the payment date will not be permitted to attend the event. Fund-raising activities will be facilitated by TFT and Team staff members to help off-set some costs. There will also be links provided to Government Funding opportunities for individual players.
5. Uniform and Levies	To uphold a high level of professionalism, players must meet event uniform requirements. Touch Football Australia have a new uniform partner in New Balance. All previous uniforms and Tas Thunder gear from Inferno is now unable to be worn to any tournaments. Uniform orders for the NYC tournament are being done differently in 2025. Each participant will be able to order directly through the New Balance on-line portal. Once this is established by New Balance I will supply the appropriate links. An approximate



deadline for Uniform Orders will be Wednesday 4th June. We may include an earlier deadline for payment and ordering of training gear, so the players get to train in the team uniform for a longer period of time (tbc). The approximate cost for compulsory uniform items will be \$240. This includes playing shorts and singlet, training shirt, off-field shorts and a polo shirt. There will be numerous other items available for purchase including backpacks, hats and visors, socks and hoodies.

The Player Levy amount (approx. \$550) will be payable through MySideline. The appropriate links to register and pay will be supplied in the next edition of this information package. Player levies are due for payment no later than Friday 5th July.

No player with a debt to TFA will be permitted to take the field at NYC in 2025. Pre-existing debts **must** be finalised prior to travel.

6. Medical Information and Tour Agreement

The tour will be supported by a sports trainer who will provide basic medical and sports therapy treatment throughout the event.

All parents/guardians who are travelling with their child to the tournament are required to have the relevant and up-to-date medical information at hand throughout the tournament.

7. Arrival and Release

We advise all players and officials to arrive in Coffs Harbour on Monday 29th September. Individual team coaches/managers may specify their own arrangements for Tuesday 30th, such as a team training session or practice match. All teams will be asked to attend a Tas Thunder BBQ/gathering on the evening of Tuesday September 30th at a venue to be advised in Coffs Harbour.

There will be a tour trophy presentation session on Saturday 4th October at the team tent at the fields. This will commence at approximately 2pm (schedule dependent on team game times on the day) and takes about 30 minutes. Teams may conduct their own post-tournament event following the tour presentations. We recommend players/officials plan further travel (home or elsewhere) for Sunday October 5.

8. Travel insurance

Travel insurance for the event is the responsibility of the individual. While you are covered at the event for any injuries that occur in relation to Touch Football activities, TFA accepts no responsibility and makes no assurances that theft, damage or accident won't occur at the event. Please ensure you have adequate travel insurance or home and contents insurance that will cover you in the event that something occurs. Furthermore, TFA encourages individuals not to bring unnecessary valuables to the event, in particular the fields, as we cannot ensure their security.

9. Withdrawals

We understand circumstances can change between the time of your selection and the actual event. This considered, any player who notifies TFA of their need to withdraw from the event with the relevant documentation prior to **Friday August 1, 2025** will be accepted and their player levy refunded.



	Notification must be made in writing to kim.williams@touchfootball.com.au. Relevant documentation includes a doctor's certificate or letter from an employer. Players who withdraw after this date may forfeit their player levy. Any such withdrawal will be reviewed on a case by case basis, with a determination to be made and the matter final. Any fees deemed to be outstanding will need to be paid by the individual.
